

**NORTH CAROLINA RADIOLOGICAL EMERGENCY VOLUNTEER CORPS
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

Oversight of the Radiological Emergency Volunteer Corps (REVC) is shared between the Office of Emergency Medical Services (OEMS), Division of Public Health (DPH), Radiation Protection Section (RPS), Emergency Management (NCEM), the Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) Program, and the Team of Radiological Emergency Volunteer (TOREV) and administered by the REVC Coordinator and Leadership Group. The primary mission of the REVC is to support local, regional and state agencies in the event of nuclear or radiological emergencies through the setup and staffing of population monitoring facilities within established community reception and/or congregate care centers.

REVC Volunteer:

I, _____, do hereby agree to serve as a volunteer of the North Carolina Radiological Emergency Volunteer Corps (REVC). As a volunteer, I agree to the following:

1. To complete the required REVC training curriculum developed and endorsed by the above mentioned North Carolina agencies.
2. To participate in semiannual meetings as scheduled by the REVC Leadership Group that will include continuing education and awareness of program updates.
3. To maintain professionalism and not divulge information regarding persons or personnel who may enter reception/congregate care centers to non-REVC members.
4. To respond as requested during events, training or emergency, provide response status reports to the REVC Coordinator as requested, and participate in after action reporting and corrective action planning processes following the conclusion of these events.
5. To assist the REVC Leadership Group in planning and/or presenting educational offerings necessary to publicize the functions of the REVC to key audiences and agencies.
6. To maintain an updated profile in the North Carolina Volunteer Registry, ServNC.
7. To not self-deploy to any identified emergency event.
8. To read and abide by all requirements set forth in the REVC's Bylaws and Standard Operational Procedures.
9. To notify the REVC Leadership Group in the event I must become inactive from activities for some period of time and subsequently when I am again able to participate on the REVC.

I fully understand that any breach in the performance of activities deemed to be in direct conflict of interest with the REVC or their operations will result in immediate dismissal from the REVC

I also agree to voluntarily resign from the REVC at such time when personal and/or professional commitments do not permit compliance with all aspects of this memorandum.

I have submitted an application for membership in the Radiological Emergency Volunteer Corps (REVC) which is true to the best of my knowledge. I acknowledge that my participation is voluntary however I agree to maintain my qualifications and receive training appropriate to my position as directed by the REVC Leadership Group during my participation.
